The Chineke! Foundation is a non-profit organisation established to provide career opportunities for young Black and Minority Ethnic (BME) classical musicians in the UK and Europe. The Foundation runs two orchestras (one adult professional, one youth orchestra) which perform standard orchestral repertoire alongside the work of BME composers past and present.

Chineke! is the brainchild of Chi-chi Nwanoku OBE: "My aim is to create a space where BME musicians can walk on stage and know that they belong. If even one BME child feels that their colour is getting in the way of their musical ambitions, then I hope to inspire them, give them a platform, and show them that music, of whatever kind, is for all people."
