Asylum seekers and refugees are some of the most marginalised people in UK society. Denied mainstream benefits or housing, legally unable to work. Many are destitute or struggle with daily welfare needs.

CECF Refugee Services provides a service for all asylum seekers and refugees who come to Cambridge. There are however many practical needs that must be met both for asylum seekers and re-settled Afghan, Syrian and Sudanese refugee families. These needs are especially acute in the Winter months.

Through our Refugee Hardship Fund, we have been assisting some of the most destitute cases with short-term emergency assistance. We help asylum seekers and refugees get to vital appointments, as well as one-off expenses for food, toiletries, mobile phone top up, clothes and shoes.

However, our fund is now running low. Any financial contribution would now be most welcome in order that we can meet essential or critical needs of some of the most vulnerable people that we assist.
